- Provide adequate information, instruction, training, and supervision to enable the workforce to undertake their work safely;
- Promote the reporting of all hazards and incidents and respond through investigation and the implementation of appropriate preventative and corrective actions;
- Encourage our people to raise issues and concerns and be actively involved in implementing agreed solutions;
- Set health, safety and wellbeing targets and objectives, and report on our performance;
- Provide appropriate resources to maintain a safe workplace and support continuous improvement;
- Undertake regular audits and inspections to measure and report on our health and safety performance;
- Undertake periodic reviews of this policy and supporting systems, processes, and documents, to verify they remain relevant and fit-for-purpose.
