



Road works on the Peninsula Link Freeway continuing from 8 April 2026

Community notification

March 2026



Peninsula Link is carrying out major road works along 14 kilometres of the freeway to maintain a safe and reliable connection for drivers travelling between the Mornington Peninsula and Melbourne's south-east.

We will undertake these works in sections, rebuilding the freeway from the ground up, replacing layers of pavement below the road surface to make it stronger and better suited to road conditions.

The final stages of works will involve reconstructing the northbound carriageway of the freeway between the Moorooduc Highway and Bungower Road.

When we'll be working

Works on 8kms of the **northbound carriageway** will take place from **7pm Wednesday 8 April to 5pm Monday 8 June**.

Works will be carried out day and night, seven days a week to complete the upgrades as efficiently and safely as possible.

All dates are subject to weather and site conditions.

Upcoming traffic changes: From 7pm 8 April to 5 pm 8 June

To ensure the safety of motorists and our workers, the following staged road and ramp closures will be in place within the work zone.

Northbound carriageway:

- Peninsula Link will be closed between the Moorooduc Highway and Bungower Road from **7pm Wednesday 8 April to 5pm Monday 8 June**.

- Northbound entry ramps from Mornington Tyabb Road and the Moorooduc Highway will be closed, as well as the exit ramp to Bungower Road. Detour via the Moorooduc Highway and Bungower Road.

The northbound service centres will remain open at all times.

Motorists are advised to plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and follow the instructions of traffic controllers and signage around the worksite.

- noise from machinery and equipment.


